

Adult Bible Study

We currently have a group that meets every Thursday at 11am in the Pastor's Office. We also, from time to time, have study groups that meet after church on Sunday and/or on weekday evenings. All are welcome to be a part of these groups. We normally study the weekly lectionary readings along with other scripture texts either by topic or by theme. Have an idea for a study group? Please let us know-we're always happy to hear new ideas!

Confirmation Class

This class runs September-June and is for students 9th grade and older. We study the Bible, church history, and theology. We also learn about our own Terryville Congregational Church. We go on retreat together, we visit other churches, and we do service projects. On the first Sunday in June, students are invited to affirm their baptism and they are confirmed as members of our church.

Women's and Men's Fellowship

Your presence automatically enrolls you in our women's and men's fellowship groups. While our men's group is just getting started, our women's group is extremely active with events and programs throughout the year: "Church Mice" who bake and do other wonderful things around the church; an annual "Spirited Sisters" retreat to Silver Lake in Sharon, Conn.; and a monthly women's discussion group.

Fellowship Events

We have an active fellowship committee that organizes lectures, bus trips, health and wellness events, and more!

New Members

If you are interested in joining our church, we receive new members twice per year, November and May. Orientation sessions are held in the month prior, October and April, respectively.

Sunday School, VBS, Youth Group, & TCC Theatre

Sunday school is for children pre-K through High School, and all are welcome! We follow an interactive curriculum which combines Bible story, craft, music, and drama. We also host an ecumenical Vacation Bible School week every July which is open to the entire community. Sunday school hosts many events throughout the year such as a Chili cookoff, Halloween party, Epiphany Pageant, Chocolate Festival, and penny carnival. We also give Bibles to all of our young people. Our High School Youth Group meets on the last Sunday of the month from September through May, and has additional outings, fellowship & service projects in our community. We also now have TCC Theatre which produces yearly plays and which involves actors from all over the state.

Worship and Music Ministry

As you can see and hear when you worship with us, worship is central in our lives and music is very important to us! All are welcome to participate in worship by being a lay reader, lifting up prayer requests, donating flowers, or serving as an usher. The Sacrament of Holy Communion is held on the first Sunday of each month, and the Sacrament of Baptism is held upon request. Also, join our Adult Choir, Bell Choir, and Cherub Choir! Choirs rehearse on Thur. evenings, and Cherub Choir rehearses directly after worship on Sundays. Choirs normally sing and play September-June, and the summer is filled with volunteer soloists and instrumentalists. Please share your musical talent and interest with us as we strive to praise God through music! And after worship, come check out our lively coffee hour with meaningful chats and usually something to munch on as well!

Our church hosts quarterly meals at Gosinski Park and Eli Terry Retirement Community. Volunteers are always needed and welcome! Our church also supports our local food pantry, human services, and any other local project that comes our way! We send care packages to our troops. We also host Easter basket and Christmas giveaways to our church families in need. We also regularly host student interns from Yale Divinity School.
