Lisbeth's - Pueblo Nuevo, Darien, Panama

Lisbeth is a hardworking woman from the town of Pueblo Nuevo. She belongs to the Wounaan indigenous group. She is always trying to improve the quality of life for herself and her family. Due to her leadership in her community she was one of the members that founded her community bank, where she also worked as a treasurer. Lisbeth eventually became a technician for Global Brigades after displaying impeccable work ethic. Previously she has requested more than five loans through her time at her community bank and has paid back all of those loans on time without any issues. This impressive performance was the reason Lisbeth was given the opportunity to apply for a Kiva loan. She is extremely excited because with this loan she was able to finish building her house and invest in her small plantain business. Congratulations to Lisbeth for her ability to complete payments on her first Kiva loan.

Yerardin Tatiana - Manta, Ecuador - Business Expansion

Yerardin Tatiana is 21 years old. She has a partner and two daughters. Her partner is a bricklayer and they live in Manta, one of the most important cities in terms of business and tourism on the Ecuadorian coast. Yerardin is an enterprising woman who works hard daily to raise her daughters. She owns a business which sells lotions and creams. This loan has helped her to expand her business and continue to pursue her dream that her daughters lack nothing. Best wishes to Yerardin as she continues to expand her business and pursue her dream.

New Loan

Rna - Jenin City, West Bank, Palestine - Poultry Farming

Rna is a hardworking woman who tries her utmost to help her family live a decent life. She is a 38-year-old refugee, living with her family in a village near Jenin, West Bank. She works in poultry breeding in order to meet her family's needs. Rna turned to Palestine for Credit and Development (FATEN) to request a loan to buy more poultry and fodder. This will improve her work and enhance her income.

More about this loan -This loan helps Palestinian people, specifically those living in refugee camps throughout the West Bank and Gaza. Palestinian refugee camps have inadequate infrastructure and don't receive the same basic services compared to other Palestinian territories. By supporting this loan, we are helping marginalized people develop their business and meet other important financial needs.

Edna - Altavas, Aklan, Phillipines - Clothing

Edna is a single woman, 27 years old with one child. Edna has a buy-and-sell ready-to-wear business in the Philippines. Edna requested a loan to buy additional stocks of clothes, dresses, pants, underwear, and other ready-to-wear items to sell. Edna has been in this business for three years. She would like to save enough to provide a secure future for her family.
